Detailed Property Data (Assessor)

Any request for detailed property and appraisal data from the County Assessor's office should be directed to DOT.Comm at servicedesk@dotcomm.org. The parcel data listed above contains only basic information – Parcel ID and Address. Custom data requests for the Assessor data are priced at a \$65.00 setup fee plus \$0.015 per record.

Custom Data Requests and Hard-Copy Maps

Any requests for hard-copy maps, custom digital file formats, or custom GIS analysis and/or processing will be regarded as a custom request. Custom requests are billed at a time & materials rate, based on

the resources utilized by GIS staff to fulfill the request. A minimum one business day is needed to complete custom GIS data or map requests.
